

IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO VOLUNTEER AS A COACH, ASSISTANT COACH, REFEREE, TEAM PARENT OR ANY OTHER VOLUNTEER POSITION, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

Registration for the Fall/Spring seasons will be held on Saturday, April 30, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. at Malow Junior High School. The EAYSO (www.eayso.org) system will be up and working on April 10, 2011 to accept player and volunteer pre-registration.

EVEN IF YOU HAVE REGISTERED IN THE PAST, YOU MUST REGISTER EACH YEAR!!!

Under AYSO guidelines, a 'Registered Volunteer' is a person who has completed the Volunteer Registration process, which includes completing the pre-registration form, sending by mail or deliver in person to the CVPA who will complete the registration process in eAYSO. Coaches and Referees must also attend job-specific training classes and complete the AYSO Safe Haven course. Until you have completed the necessary steps, you are not considered a Registered Volunteer, nor are you protected by the National AYSO Organization.

To fill out a Volunteer Registration form you must log on to www.eayso.org and follow the instructions for registration as a volunteer and complete the online application.

- ✓ Print out two copies (three copies for a youth volunteer)
- ✓ Sign all copies where indicated
- ✓ BRING ALL COPIES WITH YOU TO REGISTRATION ON April 30, 2011 or MAIL to the address below.

These forms must be completed by all AYSO volunteers, including Board Members, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Referees, Team Parents and any other person who volunteers.

You may also download the form from the main AYSO website (www.ayso.org) fill out two copies by hand, sign them and BRING THEM TO REGISTRATION.

Safe Haven for Coaches and Referees as well as Coach Training is available online at www.aysotraining.org, however, you must register and have your AYSO ID number in order to participate. (Returning volunteers can get their AYSO number by logging on to eayso.org. Your ID number will be on the lower left side next to your name). New volunteers must submit their signed forms before an AYSO ID number can be issued.

COACHES AND ASSISTANT COACHES MUST HAVE SAFE HAVEN TO COACH! YOU ONLY HAVE TO TAKE THE ONLINE CLASS ONE TIME!
